

Holy Week & Eas

This year we had a very reflective lead up to Holy Week and Easter. During our week of reflection Sr. Eileen lead us prayerfully each morning through the Passion in St. Mark's Gospel. Ann, Teresa and Peter facilitated the Amoris programme reflecting on family life. On the Wednesday night we had a Holy Hour and on Friday night Sarah led the music for Taizé Prayer. There are many different ways to enter into the stillness of God and on Thursday night Denise and Ann introduced us to Mindfulness. Each morning began with Morning Prayer and the day finished with Night Prayer. In the Church Peter offered an interactive way to prayer through the Stations of the Cross. During the week the children from Second Class in St. Cronan's JNS prayed the Stations of the Cross in the Church. Thank you to all who facilitated and led this week.

Holy Week is a special time in the Churches year and from the moment you entered the Church you could sense the atmosphere as our Sacristy team had the statues covered and the Sanctuary bare except for the essentials. On Holy Thursday Maryanne, Kieran and Sandra who are involved with the RCIA and Baptism Teams represented the Parish at the Chrism Mass in the Pro Cathedral. At the Mass of the Lord's Supper they presented the Oils and the Washing of Feet reflecting our preparation for the World Meeting of Families and several generations got their feet washed and the whole congregation renewed their commitment to service by the washing of Hands. Peter led us in the Watch and Pray which brought us through Jesus' time in the Garden of Gethsemane.

Good Friday began with Morning Prayer and then the Family Mass Team took the idea of Families sharing their faith with an interactive Stations of the Cross which engaged everyone in participation in Jesus' journey to Calvary. At 3:00pm Fr. Bibin led the Passion and Veneration of the Cross. In its simplicity it is a powerful ceremony. In India it is a ceremony where the celebrant is usually expected to preach for at least 45mins! So maybe next year!!

In the evening the Youth Choir brought us through the Stations of the Cross that Trócaire had put together based on their Lenten Campaign this year. It got us to think differently and the excellent music helped us to pray.

On Holy Saturday the Church was transformed from the subdued colours of Lent to the burst of Easter yellow by the flowers that Maura arranged with great creativity. The Easter Garden that Paschal and Mary put together really brought the resurrection scene alive. We got a surprise gift of chrysanthemums which lifted the whole Church.

At the Easter Vigil the 164th Brackenstown Scout Unit provided the fire and the sausages and during the ceremony we welcomed Kornel, Eddie and Esther into our Parish Family. On Easter Sunday we welcomed Isla and Hazel at the 11:00am Mass and Senan and Leo at the 12:30pm Mass.

Throughout the ceremonies our Choir lifted our spirits and it was great to have Aileen back with us. The choir have been very dedicated through all the weeks and Maria and Gerry have done Trojan work in keeping them on track.

The final part of our Easter celebrations was the Divine Mercy Devotions last Sunday which were a very prayerful celebration of God's extraordinary love for us.

Thank you to all who facilitated our times of prayer and celebration. Holy Week and Easter really bring out the very best in people working together whether it be in the liturgies, delivering envelopes, counting money, keeping the place right and so many other things. Finally to thank Louise for keeping the place on track in the Parish Office and Christie for keeping the place looking well. And to Peter and Fr. 
