

You must have booked for Mass for Christmas.

Your ticket has been emailed to you by now or else you have to collect your ticket from the Parish Office before Tuesday 22nd December.

## You must bring your ticket to Mass or you will not get into the Church.

You must wear a mask during Mass.

Sanitise your hands before entering the Church.

Arrive 20mins before the Mass and queue, leaving 2mts between you and others.

Follow the directions of the stewards.

Your seats are pre-assigned. Please stay in your seat for the duration of the Mass until the stewards invite you to leave.

#### The congregation is not to sing during the Mass.

Holy Communion or a Blessing will be brought to you.

Please take home anything that you bring into the Church.

Respect 2metre(6 ft) Social Distancing in the Church and Carpark.

For those who cannot attend for health reasons, Holy Communion will be distributed outside the Church from 11:15am to 11:55am on Christmas Day.

Our Bambinelli Blessing, the blessing of the infant for the crib will take place at the three Masses this weekend. Our crib will be blessed during the Angelus on Christmas Eve and the bambinelli will be

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults
