OUR LADY OF FATIMA

Saturday May 13th 2017 marks the 100th anniversary of the apparitions at Fatima.

The famous apparitions of the Virgin Mary to the children of Fatima took place during the First World War, in the summer of 1917. The inhabitants of this tiny village in the diocese of Leiria (Portugal) were mostly



poor people, many of them small farmers who went out by day to tend their fields and animals.

The three children who received the apparitions had been brought up in an atmosphere of genuine piety: Lucia dos Santos (ten years old) and her two younger cousins, Francisco and Jacinta. Together they tended the sheep and, with Lucy in charge, would often pray the Rosary kneeling in the open. On Sunday, May 13, 1917, toward noon, a flash of lightning drew the attention of the children, and they saw a brilliant figure appearing over the trees of the Cova da Iria. The "Lady" asked them to pray for the conversion of sinners and an end to the war, and to come back every month, on the 13th.

ST CRONAN'S STATUE UPDATE

The statue of St Cronan will be dedicated and blessed by Bishop Field on Pentecost Sunday 4th June. Sculptor Seighean O Draoi has kindly sent a new photo which shows the statue of St Cronan in progress. He and all of his brother monks were martyred on a single night by a party of sea-raiders. The annals mention two dates, AD 631 & 636. The image of a Christian martyr traditionally depicts the means by which the martyrdom occurred, hence the image of the sea-raiders' ship. The ruins of the Nunnery/Glasmore Abbey located in Lioscian estate are believed to indicate the original site of St Cronan's monastery. Donation envelopes are available at the back of Church. So far we have raised €4,205 of the €5,302 cost of

the project. We still need to raise €1,097, can you help?. All donations of €20 or more will receive a St Cronan Statue donation certificate.
