Relationship and Sexuality Education (RSE)

The National Council for Curriculum and Assessment (NCCA) have been tasked with reviewing the content and methodology of the teaching of Relationship and Sexuality Education in Primary and Post Primary Schools. While this review is welcomed the proposal being put to the Government is that RSE should be taught in a 'value free' way meaning that how we understand our relationships and sexuality will not take into account our faith values. The Diocesan Education Office as well as that of the Irish Bishops Conference have raised their concerns with the NCCA. But it is up to parents to look at what is being proposed and then submit their concerns directly to the NCCA. If you want the programme to take into account the moral values of our faith then it is important to make this known by the 25th October 2019. You can do this by reading the proposal and making a submission on their website by searching for "ncca rse review". There you can read the draft report and complete the online survey.
