## COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFI DEPARTED

#### **COMMEMORATION OF ALL SOULS** Plenary Indulgence Decree 2020

- 1. In the Month of November all who have confessed, made an Act of Spiritual Communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a Church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made on the Saturdays during the month (10:45-11:30am).
- 2. The faithful who visit a cemetery (even if it is mentally) and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day for the Month of November.

The Decree suggests that such prayer take place before an "image of Jesus or the Blessed Virgin Mary". Among the various prayers that are recommended are "prayers for the deceased, Morning or Evening Prayer from the Office of the Dead, the Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, meditating on various Gospel passages proposed for the liturgy of the Dead, or completing a work of mercy by offering to God the suffering and discomforts of one's own life".


