# Finance News

**ANNUAL RECEIPTS** have been posted out to all contributors. We have made every effort to ensure accuracy, but if you have any questions please contact the Parish Office.

**EASTER DUES:** the envelopes have been included with the receipts in an effort to use less paper. There will be Dues Envelopes also available at the back of the Church. This contribution together with the First Collection supports Fr. Paul and Fr. Bibin and the sick and retired priests in the Diocese. Please return in the collection on Sunday or to the white post boxes.

**Please include both spouses' names on the Easter Dues envelopes**

If you pay tax and you contribute more than €250 to the Parish in a calendar year, this then enables the Parish to reclaim the tax paid on your contributions. Your Easter Dues offering can be included as part of the €250 base figure. Unfortunately, the Revenue now only allow this if the name of the primary tax payer in the family is included on the Dues envelope. For instance: if we make up a fictional couple Michael and Mary Murray: they are married, with Mary being the primary tax payer. We wouldn't be allowed to include the Murray offering if their Dues envelope was only in the name of Michael Murray. **The ideal is to include both names**, Michael and Mary Murray, to be sure of inclusion in the tax reclaim. Also allowable would be the Murray Family or Mary Murray. Single or widowed contributors are not affected as their Dues offering will be in their own name anyhow.

## Fanning the Flame in Wembley

Ask any Englishman – Wembley is hallowed ground, sacred space. It's where every football team wants to play, and where every band wants to perform. It's also – and we're talking Wembley Arena here, not quite the stadium – where every other year, 10,000 young Catholics come together to celebrate their faith. Flame Congress started back in 2012. The newly-formed Catholic Youth Ministry Federation for England & Wales (CYMFed) decided to build on the success of their events for adult youth workers and

their strong showing at the 2010 visit of Pope Benedict, by creating something not really seen in the UK before outside of those papal visits – a huge national gathering of Catholic young people, complete with the biggest speakers, the best musicians, and all supported

by pretty much every diocese, major religious order and new movement in the country!

That first Flame back in 2012 had a strong focus on the upcoming London Olympics. Two Christian athletes from Team GB gave their testimonies, along with a handful of others,

and we knew that something positive had begun. The next event followed in 2015, after which the decision was taken that from that point onwards Flame would be a bi-annual event, happening every odd-numbered year. This year's Flame was the best yet. In fact, I have to say, it's one of the best events I've been to in almost twenty years in Catholic youth and young adult ministry. There's so much about it that worked, but by far the best thing was the quality of the speakers and the fact that the organisers didn't try to overcomplicate the message.


