The Sacrament of Confession is available on Saturday mornings from 10:45am to 12:00noon. One of the things that we have to avoid during the restrictions is crowds gathering while waiting on Sacraments.

We have seen what has happened with Holy Communion. We want to be able to continue to provide Confession so we need your help, understanding and co-operation.

We are going to break down the Confession time into 5 fifteen minute slots. In each fifteen minutes there will be room for five people for Confession.

A sheet inside the Main door is where you can reserve a place in the fifteen minute slots by putting your initials. You can only be in the Church during the 15 min slot as you wait on the bench nearest the Pastoral Centre. Please do not wait around the Church and only come in at the beginning of the 15 minute slot you reserve.

We will try this for the next couple of weeks to see how it works but there can be no more than five people waiting at any time for Confession. There will be a steward there to guide people.

We don't want to have to stop the Sacrament of Confession so we have to adapt to protect it.
