THE PARISH PASTORAL CENTRE

In August James Ahern Architects and Duke Construction handed over our beautiful Parish Pastoral Centre and very quickly it has become a great asset for us. For many years the dream of having a facility like this has been discussed and thanks to our Pastoral Centre Development Group that dream has become a reality. There are a wide variety of things taking place in the Centre and in the year ahead we hope to develop more activities to build up our community.

What's available in the Pastoral Centre?

The Parish Office: is now located in the heart of the Centre. Opening hours Monday – Friday 9:30am – 1:00pm.

Coffee/Tea After Mass: on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday our Hospitality Team offer refreshments after the 10:00am Mass. We will expand this as we get more volunteers.

Bible Study: every Monday evening from 7:30 – 8:30pm.

Swords Unit of the Order of Malta: meet on a Wednesday evening from 8:30pm.

Mother and Baby Group: meet on a Thursday morning from 10:45 – 12:00noon.

St. Vincent de Paul Conference: meet every second Wednesday.

Scoil Rince Naomh Bríd: Irish Dancing for children meet on Monday afternoon at 2:30pm

The Parish Pastoral Council: hold their monthly meetings.

CASA (Caring and Sharing Association): have their monthly social for teenagers.

We have also hosted Prayer Workshops, Sacramental Preparation for First Communion and Confirmation Parents, Hospitality after events and general meetings.

EPIPHANY GIFTS APPEAL

On the Feast of the Epiphany (Tuesday 6th January) when we celebrate the visit of the Magi bearing gifts to the infant Jesus, we invite you to bring an extra gift you have received for Christmas that you would like to pass on to someone else.

**EXTRACT FROM *MISERICORDIAE VULTUS*
(THE YEAR OF MERCY DOCUMENT)
BY POPE FRANCIS**

At times we are called to gaze even more attentively on mercy so that we may become a more effective sign of the Father's action in our lives. For this reason I have proclaimed an Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy as a special time for the Church, a time when the witness of believers might grow stronger and more effective.

The Holy Year will open on 8 December 2015, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. This liturgical feast day recalls God's action from the very beginning of the history of mankind. After the sin of Adam and Eve, God did not wish to leave humanity alone in the throes of evil. And so he turned his gaze to Mary, holy and immaculate in love (cf. Eph 1:4), choosing her to be the Mother of man's Redeemer. When faced with the gravity of sin, God responds with the fullness of mercy. Mercy will always be greater than any sin, and no one can place limits on the love of God who is ever ready to forgive. I will have the joy of opening the Holy Door on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. On that day, the Holy Door will become a Door of Mercy through which anyone who enters will experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instils hope. (Paragraph 3)
