

On Tuesday 21st February 2017 Cardinal Desmond Connell passed away peacefully in his sleep. He had served as Archbishop of Dublin from 1988 until 2004 and was made a Cardinal by Pope John Paul II in 2001. He was born in Dublin and studied for the priesthood in Holy Cross College, Clonliffe. He was ordained in 1951 and spent much of his ministry teaching in UCD. May he rest in peace.



outside ourselves to love others. The real test of Christian life. prayer and fasting is how we live our lives in the everyday. The test of Lent in the end is not what have we done for Lent. but what Lent has done for others through us. It is a sacred space to get in touch with Jesus, in death and

resurrection the man for others.




