Pope Francis - Dublin 26th August 2018 Prayer for Forgiveness For Those Hurt by Abuse

I wish to implore the Lord's mercy for these crimes and to ask forgiveness for them.
We ask forgiveness for the cases of abuse in Ireland.

For the abuse of power, the abuse of conscience
and sexual abuse on the part of representatives of the Church.
In a special way, we ask forgiveness
for all those abuses that took place in different kinds of institutions
directed by men and women religious and other members of the Church.
We also ask forgiveness for cases in which many minors
were exploited for their labour.

We ask forgiveness for all those times when, as a Church,
we did not offer to the survivors of any type of abuse compassion
and the pursuit of justice and truth by concrete actions.
We ask forgiveness.

We ask forgiveness for some members of the hierarchy
who took no responsibility for these painful situations and kept silent.
We ask forgiveness.

We ask forgiveness for those children who were taken away from their mothers
and for all those times when so many single mothers who tried to find their children
that had been taken away, or those children who tried to find their mothers,
were told that this was a mortal sin.


It is not a mortal sin;

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2021



The week of Prayer for Christian Unity begins on Monday, 18th January. The theme this year is Abiding in Christ and was prepared by the sisters in the Community of Grandchamp in Switzerland. It follows the rhythm of Prayer of the Divine Office. During this week of Prayer we will begin our Rosary and Night Prayer at 8:15pm and pray a section of the Prayer each night. We will bring it to conclusion in our Taizé Prayer on Friday at 7:30pm. The text will be available on our Facebook Page, website and some copies will be left at the back of the Church.

Calendar, Sacraments & Restrictions

As we begin another Level 5 restriction the only ceremonies that can take place with a congregation are Weddings (with 6 guests) and Funerals (with 10 mourners). All other ceremonies will be online only.

We have families who had booked Baptisms in 2020 who have not yet been able to celebrate this Sacrament and we will be facilitating them first before we issue dates for this year. As there is so much uncertainty what we ask you to do is email the Parish Office with your request for Baptism and include what month you would like to celebrate the Baptism. There are only ten family members with each child and a max. of four baptisms at one ceremony.

First Holy Communion and Confirmation dates will not be set until we see how restrictions continue to affect the Church being open. The Sacraments will be celebrated later than usual and there will be a restriction on numbers in the Church. This means that half a class (50 people) or at max 1 full class (100 people) at each ceremony.
