## **Safeguarding Awareness Training**

Over the past three weeks over 100 parishioners who exercise a ministry within the Parish have attend a Safeguarding Awareness Course run by Garry Kehoe of the Dublin Diocesan Safeguarding Service. For those working with children, vulnerable adults, employees and ministry leaders attend an all-day session. At present their Garda Vetting is being processed.



There is another Safeguarding Awareness Course on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> March. All those involved in ministry who have not already attended one of the courses are asked to make sure to attend this one. If there are any parishioners who would like to attend, please email Fr. Paul.

Creating a safe environment for children and vulnerable adults is the standard to which we are all working in the Church and in the Parish. To be sure that we have the best practice in our Parish these courses are necessary and I am very grateful that those involved in ministry in the Parish hold the same commitment and are engaged in an active way to ensure that we stick to what is asked of us by the Diocese and the State.

We have three Safeguarding Representatives in the Parish: Mary Liz Donoghue, Nicola Gregan and Colette Burke. Their role is to check that all that we have in place for safeguarding of children is done properly, this includes that the information signs in the porches are clear and are up to date, that all groups have a sign-in record for children, that children are properly supervised and that parents/guardians are informed of our Code of Conduct and procedures. They also receive directly information from the Diocese about promoting Safeguarding in our Parish.

## Introduction of an envelope system for the 1st collection

Thank you to those who have returned First Collection envelope forms. If you intend to taking part in the scheme please return your form as soon as possible as the First Collection envelope books will be issued shortly. As mentioned there are substantial benefits to the Parish to be gained by using an envelope system for the First Collection at no extra cost to anyone. Normally cash placed in the First Collection does not qualify for Tax Relief as it cannot be traced back to the donor. Your participation in the scheme is only of added benefit to the Parish if you pay income tax. Information sheets on how this scheme works are available on the tables at the back of the church. We invite those who would like to participate in this scheme to return the forms as soon as possible. Thank you for your generous support of our Parish.

# HISTORY OF ST CRONAN'S ADULT CHOIR ...continued

## from last week

The Millennium Year of 2000 was a very busy one for the choir. We organised a "Songs of Praise" for the choirs and congregations of the Fingal Deanery and invited the Rathfarnham Concert Band to accompany the hymns. However, the big project for the choir was to encourage congregational singing. Laminated hymns were supplied for the Liturgical Seasons and cantors were trained. Gradually our congregations began to join us in active participation and in 2004 things really took off with the introduction of PowerPoint. Now, we are well known in Liturgical music circles as a

parish where congregational singing and interaction between our choirs and the faithful is firmly in place. Of course we were blessed with having a number of priests who themselves were good singers and very supportive of the project and this was invaluable for its implementation.

In 2002 St Cronan's Parish celebrated its Silver Jubilee. Refurbishment work was done on the church which made it a far more comfortable, warm and inviting space. The choir sang at the Mass of Rededication which took place on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December. RTE also did the outside broadcast of the Mass for Christmas Day in St Cronan's Church and the choir was joined by some of the children from the school. Our Mass of St Cronan was specially composed by Aileen Smyth for this occasion.

In June 2012 Ireland hosted the International Eucharistic Congress and our choir joined the massed choirs in Croke Park for a very memorable day. We also went to the parish of St Cronan in Roscrea where we took part in a pilgrimage walk as part of our IEC



In May 2014 we were the official choir for the Dublin Diocesan pilgrimage to Knock, a most successful and enjoyable trip. In 2015, the choir was asked to pilot a new Mass (Mass of St Mel for Choir and

Congregation). This Mass was composed by Dr John O'Keeffe, Professor of Sacred Music in St Patrick's College, Maynooth. It was specially commissioned for the rededication of St Mel's Cathedral. Dr O'Keeffe was invited to Brackenstown to hear our congregation sing and was very impressed with the level of participation.

At present the membership of the choir stands at twenty-six. We have been very lucky this year to welcome five new members, four ladies and one gentleman. We

like to think our repertoire is intergenerational, keeping the best of the old, but always on the look-out for modern hymns that are scripture-based and appealing and will stand the test of time. We use guitars, flute, violin and cello for special occasions. We are always ready to welcome new members and musicians.




