Swords Cemetery Sunday – Sunday 26th June at 4.00pm: This Mass (with the participation of the Choir) will take place in St. Colmcille's Church. Before the final blessing, I will pray a prayer of blessing for all buried in the Cemetery. This is always a significant event in our parish Calendar and is an important annual occasion, therefore as you would expect a lot of work goes into this Mass by the Liturgy Team. If you want to 'hear', celebrate the Mass I invite you to come into the Church, or at least gather around the front door. There will be no use of a sound system that will reach the 'four corners' of the cemetery.

Individual Graves: The Mass itself, is offered for all buried in our cemetery and the prayer of blessing refers to all buried 'in this cemetery. To that end there is no need for all graves to be individually sprinkled and nor will that happen. What I will do after the Mass is 'sprinkle' the different sections of the graveyard. Why not bring a small bottle of holy water and sprinkle your family grave during the Mass.

Éigse Cholmcille is a new initiative supported by Cumann na Sagart (Maynooth) and An Coiste Tréadach/Pobal an Aifrinn of the Diocese of Dublin. It will be the start of a series of lectures on themes based on the Bible and Christian Literature and Spirituality. The initial event, as Gaeilge, will include a tour of Swords Castle, a lecture by Fr. Philip Baxter O. Carm. a concelebrated Mass and will finish up with a Seisiún ceoil. The first of the series of lectures will be held in the St Cronan's Parish Centre, Brackenstown.

Brackenstown Bible Study Classes have now finished for the summer break. This year we are following a 24 class study of St Matthew's Gospel, the 41 people who are taking part are finding it to be of great benefit. Perhaps you would have liked to join the class but were unable to do so because of family, work or other commitments? If so you may be interested to know that Frances Hogan from Celbridge has a video series of c.25 minute talks on YouTube. The series is called voyage, a journey through the Gospel of St Matthew. In addition, EWTN are currently showing Frances Hogan's TV program "Matthew's Testimony to Jesus". The programmes are 30 minutes in length and can be seen at 7am on Sunday and 12.30am on Thursday. Here in St Cronan's our own study of St Matthew's Gospel resumes on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> September. Also to let you know that our 2019 Scripture classes will cover a 20 week study of the "Acts of the Apostles" The class size will again be limited to c. 40 people and the cost of the workbook is €25. Sixteen people have already reserved and paid for their places on the 2019 study.
