making a directed retreat in the midst of our busy day. The retreat is for everyone and the structure is simple and can be adapted to the needs of each.


The Week of Directed Prayer begins on Sunday evening with a group session to introduce participants to the format of the week; to give some explanation of Praying With Scripture; to spend some time in prayer together; to introduce retreatants to their personal guide for the week; to give any other information that people may need at the start of their retreat ... and to share some light refreshments together!! The retreat is Scripture-based and the format is based on making a half hour prayer each day reflecting on a particular scripture passage, letting it speak to them in their present life situation, and then coming to the parish each day to talk about their prayer experience with a trained Prayer Guide.

These one-to-one sessions run from Monday to Friday at a time convenient to each retreatant.

On the closing evening (Friday/Saturday?) everyone comes together again to share their experience and to bring the week to a prayerful closing.

HISTORY OF ST CRONAN'S ADULT CHOIR

St Cronan's Choir was founded in February 1975 and consisted of about thirty singers, some of whom still sing with us today. The first director of the choir was John O'Rourke and the organist was Celine Hussey (R.I.P. 2000).

The choir made its début on St. Patrick's Day 1975, at the 11.30 Mass, in the school hall.

The first big occasion for the choir was the official opening of the brand new St Cronan's Church on December 11th, 1977. At that time, St Sylvester's Choir in Malahide was starting up and their members joined us for the opening ceremony. For some time afterwards, some of the St Cronan members sang with the Malahide choir on Sundays until both choirs became established.

Since its foundation in 1976, four people have been involved in training the choir to date. Áine Shields took over from John O'Rourke and Aileen Smyth, who started off as a chorister, succeeded Celine Hussey as accompanist. When Áine retired, Patricia Bourke directed the choir for several years. Since 1998 Aileen has been both choir director and accompanist.

Over the years the choir has had many outings, projects and workshops. Very early on we went out to Ballyboughal to do a wedding, travelling in very poor conditions due to snow and ice. When we got to the church, we discovered there had been a power cut and the organ wasn't working. An ancient harmonium with a bellows was produced, much to Celine's dismay. One person had to be appointed to keep the bellows going!

In 1979 we joined the massed choirs in the Phoenix Park on the occasion of the visit of Pope St John Paul II. We sang in a competition in Navan Choral Festival. We travelled to Ratharney Co. Meath and to Inistioge in Kilkenny as guest choir, joining in and sharing repertoire with the singers in these churches. We also had a very moving Celtic Prayer Service in the wonderful setting of Clonmacnoise.

We organised several workshops for the Fingal choirs, under the auspices of the Irish Church Music Association.

Introduction of an envelope system for the 1st collection

St Cronan Statue

St Cronan Statue for Church Grounds. 2017 marks 40 years since our Church was opened. The Parish has commissioned a significant piece of artwork to mark the occasion and to honour our patron, St Cronan. There will be donation envelopes available next weekend and we invite you to assist with the €5,302 cost of the project. Safeguarding Children and Vulnerable Adults

Our Parish is committed to best practice in the participation of children and vulnerable adults in our community. The legal requirements recently changed and a new form of Garda Vetting was introduced. Now everyone who is working with children must be Garda Vetted and complete a Training Day on Child Safeguarding. In addition to this the Archdiocese has stipulated that anyone visiting vulnerable adults must also do this training and be Garda Vetted. All those who work with children in the Church as well as those who bring Holy Communion to people at home, our Funeral Ministry Team and those employed by or hold positions of leadership in the Parish, will do their training on the 11th February in the Pastoral Centre.

THE PARISH DIARY IS AVAILABLE ON THE WEBSITE

All people who participate in Ministry in any way in the Parish will have to attend a Child Safeguarding Awareness Talk which will take place on 7th February or 7th March. They

are not being asked to be Garda Vetted but their attendance at the talk is required.

All of these measures are to continue our best practice in caring for our children and vulnerable adults in the Parish.


