Church Reopening

On Tuesday 1st December the Church opened again for public worship. There are conditions that we have to follow which are the same as when we were open in the summer.

- ◆ The Church is split into two pods of 50 for all Masses.
- ◆ If you enter by the right main door, nearest the Grotto, you stay on that side and leave by the side door.
- ◆ If you enter by the left main door, nearest the Pastoral Centre, you stay on that side and leave by the Pastoral Centre door.
- ◆ Please follow the directions of the stewards.
- ◆ Face masks must be worn.
- ◆ Hands must be sanitised as you enter the Church.
- ◆ Holy Communion will be brought to your seat and you receive on the hand.
- ◆ Kneeling is limited to certain parts of the Church.
- ◆ The Church closes immediately after Mass and reopens once it has been cleaned.
- ◆ Masses will continue to be broadcast on the webcam and you can receive Holy Communion after Mass.
- ◆ If you are diagnosed with Covid19, if you have underlying health conditions, if you have a cold, then please stay at home.
- ◆ Maintain 2mts Social Distancing and please don't congregate outside the Church.
- ◆ We need more volunteers to clean between Masses.
