

A Big Thank You

It's not often that I'm either lost for words or don't know that something is going on but last Wednesday (14th) that is exactly what happened. It was really beautiful to see so many in the Pastoral Centre to celebrate the 20th anniversary of my Ordination to the Priesthood and the beginning of my ministry. Thank you to all who organized it, baked for it and celebrated it.

It may be a bit unusual to celebrate 20 years but it coincides with an even greater achievement, my parents golden wedding anniversary. They were married on the 13th September 1966 by Fr. Sean O'Neill, my Dad's cousin, and some thirty years later I was ordained on the same date in Churchtown

Looking back over twenty years is like looking to yesterday, it has passed so quickly. There have been high points and low points, challenges and changes that took courage to face. Twenty years ago it was the priests who looked at the direction of the Parish now it is the shared vision through the Pastoral Council. The stand alone Parish was to be protected at all costs whereas now there is a greater shared mission by the Parishes in an area. These are welcome changes.

The thing that I am most grateful for over the years is the privilege it is to be with families at the significant moments of their lives. Some of these are the moments of happiness in baptisms, marriage, communion and confirmation. Then there are the times of heartbreak in facing illness and losing a family member.

Answering the call to be a priest is not a once off decision it is a constant change and growth into where God continually calls me. It is an unpredictable path, but one that you have to learn that it's God's path, trust in him.

The only thing that after twenty years that is amusing is that I am still in the top 15 youngest priests! Please pray for vocations and if you are reading this and think that you or someone close to you is being called by God to be a Priest, Deacon or Religious Sister come and have a chat, that's where my path to priesthood began.
