On Monday night our Scripture group hosted a very informative and engaging talk on "The Story of Early Church Theology." The well attended talk was given by Joseph Rivera, lecturer in theology in DCU. The previous Monday we enjoyed the benefit of an equally enjoyable talk by Joseph's fellow DCU lecturer in theology, Brad Anderson on "Whose Bible is it? Judaism, Christianity and the Old Testament."

The story of Paul's conversion on the road to Damascus is recounted in the book of Acts, and would have taken place between 33 and 36 AD. He then began to preach, travelling all over the Roman Empire, preaching the Good News of the Risen Christ and founding many churches. Paul eventually began to write letters to the churches he had founded, often in response to particular issues they faced or questions they had asked in letters to him.
