

provides flexible training programmes and support services for people who need specialist support (job seekers, unemployed, people with an illness or disability). The Swords centre is based on the

Balheary Road; students attending from all over the Fingal region. NLN Swords have a range of free rehabilitative and vocational training courses. Because class sizes are small training is more individualised. All of the courses have continuous intake (so students can start at any time throughout the year), and offer nationally recognised qualifications including QQI at levels 3, 4 and 5. By completing modules, in addition to the support that is provided in centre, students feel more confident by the end of their course and job ready. NLN Swords work in partnership with local and international companies throughout the Fingal region for work placements. All courses offer hands on work placements throughout their duration. A number of students from NLN have completed work experience with St. Cronan's. One student commented that "It has been a great experience; meeting new people on the course and on work experience, making friends and of course learning..."

Upon completion of the courses, students move on to further education or employment. But overall, students see a change in their confidence and motivation which helps them to cope with the challenges of both the workplace and life in general. Another student commented that their course has given them a "new direction and some new goals to achieve for a new beginning".


